**ORDER FOR SUPERVISED VISITATION AT  
THE TOBY CENTER VISITATION CENTER**

After hearing evidence that established that: (*Check all that apply*)

- the safety of the minor child/ren
- the access of the non-residential parent

would likely be compromised and that no reasonable alternative is available except by the use of The Toby Center [hereinafter “the Visitation Center”], the Court hereby orders that:

1. Supervised visitation with \_\_\_\_\_

shall be arranged and completed through the Visitation Center. The parties shall participate and cooperate with the Visitation Center.

2. Visitation will be based primarily on concerns about: (*Check all that apply*)
  - alcohol or drug abuse
  - domestic violence
  - kidnapping
  - parental alienation
  - other

3. Visitation sessions are sixty (60) minutes in length and will be held: (***Check one***)
- weekly
  - every other week
  - monthly

4. The parties shall schedule a supervised visitation intake appointment within ten (10) days by contacting the Visitation Center at 855-862-9236 ext.1.
5. Each party is required to participate in a face-to-face intake meeting with a staff person at the Visitation Center prior to the first supervised visitation. A \$95 intake fee will be charged per party.
6. Fees for supervised visitation are as follows:

Income of Non-Custodial Parent	Fee for Supervised Visitation
Above \$80,000	\$75 per hourly session
\$60,000 to \$80,000	\$70 per hourly session
\$50,000 to \$59,999	\$65 per hourly session
\$40,000 to \$49,999	\$60 per hourly session
\$30,000 to \$39,999	\$55 per hourly session
Less than \$30,000	\$50 per hourly session
Indigent – Approved by Court Only	\$45 per hourly session

7. Payments must be made prior to the visit and failure to pay may result in a judgment against the responsible party.
8. The payment for intake fees shall be allocated to the parents as follows:
- Each parent shall be responsible for payment of his or her own intake fee.
  - Mother shall pay \_\_\_\_\_ **percentage** of the total fees owed by both parents.
  - Father shall pay \_\_\_\_\_ **percentage** of the total fees owed by both parents.
9. The payment for visitation sessions at the Visitation Center shall be allocated to the parents as follows:
- Each parent shall pay **half** of the total fees for visitation sessions owed by both parents.
  - Mother shall pay \_\_\_\_\_ **percentage** of the total fees or visitation sessions owed by both parents.
  - Father shall pay \_\_\_\_\_ **percentage** of the total fees for visitation sessions owed by both parents.

10.  ***If checked***, the Court orders that security personnel should be present during visitation due to safety concerns for the parties and/or children.

***(check one)***

Visitation Center staff may determine the level of security needed.

Or

The Court orders the following type of security to be present during visitation:  
*(off-duty law enforcement, private security, etc.)*

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The parties are responsible for fees associated with security and shall contact the Visitation Center for information on security fees.

Each parent shall pay **half** of the total fees for security owed by both parents.

11. The parties shall fully comply with this order. No party shall act in a manner that prolongs the implementation of this supervised visitation order. No party shall interrupt the supervised visitation with the child.

12. The parties shall follow the rules and directives of the staff of the Visitation center of any law enforcement or security personnel at the Visitation Center.

13. The parties shall notify the Visitation Center if they cannot keep a scheduled appointment. Failure to do so will result in being required to pay for the appointment. Continued cancellations by either party may result in suspension of visits until further order of the Court. Visitation Center staff reserves the right to terminate visitation if repeated cancellations occur.

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15. The Visitation Center shall implement this Order by all lawful means to accomplish its purpose in providing safe and regular contact between the child/ren and parent. Observation reports shall be submitted to the Court when requested by the Court or upon subpoena by a party. The Visitation Center may submit status reports to the Court as needed or upon request of the Court.

16. This case may be reviewed upon motion of either party.
