### **STAFF PSYCHOLOGIST (Pinellas County-funded) Administrative Office of the Courts Sixth Judicial Circuit CTA/E26**

#### **Description of Work:**

This position involves conducting evaluations to assist the judge in making decisions regarding treatment interventions and sanctions for children appearing before the court on delinquency charges. The evaluations include conducting a clinical interview, administration and interpretation of appropriate testing, and preparing reports for the use of the Unified Family Court in its disposition of cases. Part of the evaluation also consists of consultation with court personnel, the Department of Juvenile Justice, the school system and other community stakeholders. Work is reviewed by the Director of Behavioral Evaluations.

#### **Minimum Training and Experience Required:**

Doctorate in Psychology or Ph.D or Psy. D

Training in working with children, adolescents, and families.

Professionally licensed psychologist pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 490 is preferred however, candidates who have completed their doctorate and are ready for post-doctoral clinical hours needed for state licensure will also be considered.
